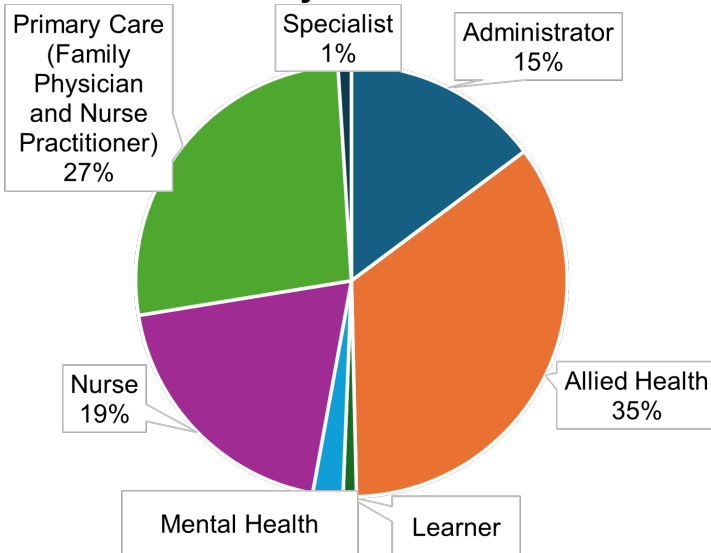

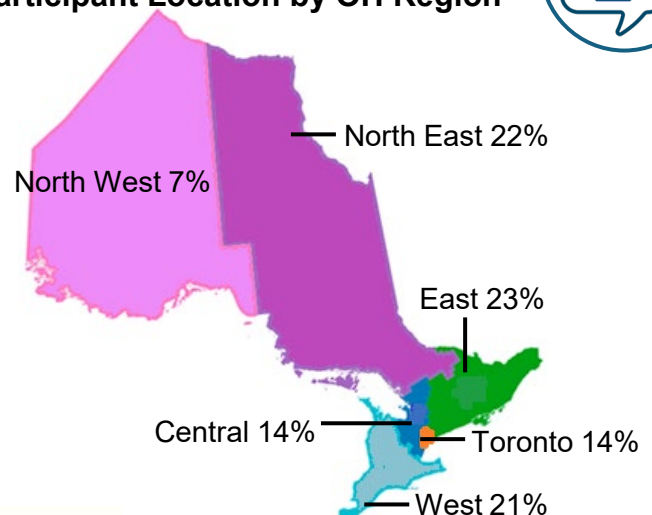


"I have recently started using the question of "How will you know it is time to move or get more help?" in my assessment of capacity to live independently. I find this is also helpful for family members to hear as well."
